- ❖ Scouts should dress appropriately in layers for program activities both indoors and outdoors.
- ❖ All children (including nonscout siblings) must pay for the program. This scout program is not appropriate for children under age 6. Siblings over age 6 are welcome unless otherwise noted.
- ❖ There is no cost for leaders or parent chaperones, and scouts must be accompanied by at least the den leader or another representative. Additional adults are welcome.
- ❖ Leaders will receive certification of requirements completed.
- ❖ Scout leaders must provide awards – no awards will be distributed during this program.
- ❖ Program will be cancelled and fees refunded if the minimum registration is not achieved. Leaders will be notified of cancellation by Wednesday before the program.
- ❖ Leaders may bring snacks for their group – snacks are not provided. Snack time is not calculated into the clinic schedule, and leaders should plan accordingly to complete required activities. Snack time should be limited to the last 15-20 minutes of the program.
